Dr. Mohammad Abdul Latif is a career bureaucrat with 25 years of experience and has been serving with different organizations with varying capacities and responsibilities. He is a member of 17<sup>th</sup> BCS Administration Cadre and joined the service in 1998. He starts his career as Assistant Commissioner in Gaibandha District. He then worked as Assistant Commissioner (Land) in Sherpur Sadar Upazila under Sherpur District and Upazila Nirbahi Officer in Gazaria Upazila under Munshigonj District. Dr. Latif also worked as Senior Assistant Secretary in the Ministry of Home Affairs and in the Ministry of Science and Technology and then as Deputy Director in BCS Administration Academy. Later on, he discharged his duties as Private Secretary to the Cabinet Secretary. He served as Deputy Secretary in the Economic Relations Division of the Ministry of Finance and in the Ministry of Public Administration.
